**Our little ones will explore Jesus' love for each one of us - his special "creations"!**

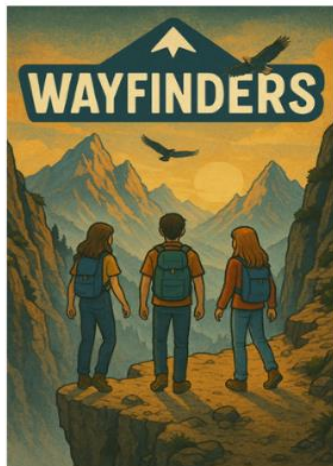
## "Discoverers"


